

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples achieve self-determination




WHO WE ARE

Woor-Dungin is a not-for-profit organisation walking alongside Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples toward self-determination. Our work is always directed by First Nations voices.

We support mob by meeting their needs, including funding from philanthropy and services from our pro bono partners. We unite peoples to achieve more than they could on their own.

Woor-Dungin means 'share' in the language of the Gunaikurnai people of south-eastern Victoria. Sharing knowledge and building respectful relationships underpins our model.

OBJECTIVES


OUTCOMES
